Goals - Bicycle Plan Implementation Committee
Author a digest version of the bicycle plan and publish on the BPAC website.
Prepare a report on the progress of implementing the bicycle plan.
Publish a Durham bike map.
Ensure Phase 1 bike plan projects are implemented or scheduled.
Build relationships with NCDOT and City/County staff involved in implementing projects that impact the bike plan.
Goals - Pedestrian Plan Implementation Committee
Author a digest version of the pedestrian plan and publish on the BPAC website.
Prepare a report on the progress of implementing the pedestrian plan.
Goals - Communications Committee
Prepare a new handout item and logo
Maintain a presence at the Farmer's Market or other community events
Hold community outreach events in conjunction with Bike to Work Week
Goals - Development Committee
Publish an internal calendar of city, county and state governmental activities that impact BPAC.
Recommend bicycle and pedestrian-related amendments to the UDO, as recommended by the bike and pedestrian plans.

Build stronger relationships with the Planning and Transportation Departments
Begin reviewing re-zoning requests
Document all processes involved in site and zoning Reviews.
Goals – Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission
Promote better regional cooperation on bicycle and pedestrian planning
Increase the amount of attention paid to bicycle and pedestrian issues in more rural areas.
Improve contacts with government leaders and PAC groups.
Expand the number of members of BPAC
Increase listserv participants
Increase outreach to and membership from minority communities.
Monitor development of ATT Phase E
Examine additional funding sources (including a letter to the 21st Century Transportation Commission)
Maintain awareness of statewide bicycle and pedestrian issues and organizations
Make the case for an additional bike-ped planner
